Requirements

 - Be a resident of Prince William County or the City of Manassas
 - have been involved in high school and/or with community theatre groups
 - Have a love of theatre and wish to continue to pursue a lifelong involvement with theatre throughout their life
- A major in theatre is not a requirement for consideration.
- Money may only be used for academic purposes – not on room and board expenses.

Criteria For Evaluation

Essay and Reference Response (Main Consideration)

- Applicant exhibits a love of theatre.
- Applicant explains why theatre is important to them.
- Applicant shares how theatre has helped them grow and given them new perspectives.
- Applicant shares how/why they plan to continue to be a lifelong participant in theatre endeavors.
